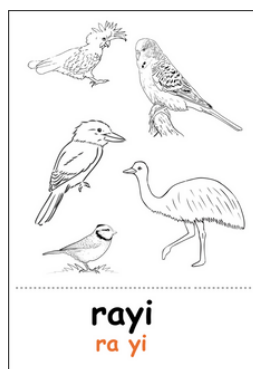

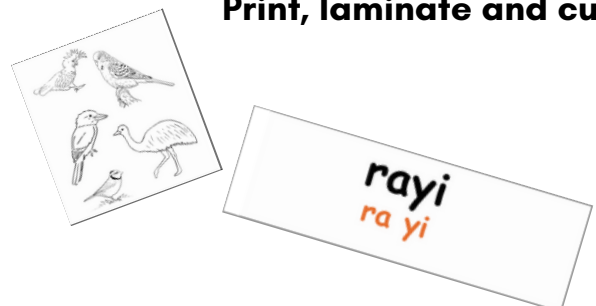

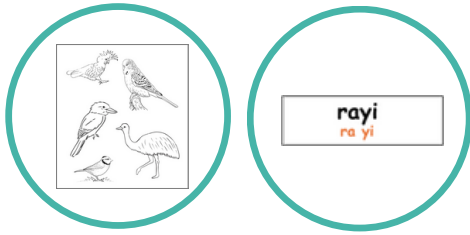

Matching Game



What you need

Instructional language

'Let's make a circle (you all).' 'Yes/No'

'Mix the word/picture paper (you, one person).'

'Hold the paper' (you, one person) 'You (one person) say it.'

'You (one person) put **word/picture** paper **down/up**'

'You (one person) turn it over'

How to play

Version 1

Learners make a circle. Lay picture and word cards face up.

Teacher says a word and chooses a learner to match the right picture and word card together, saying the word aloud each time. If they match, learner keeps the card. If not, they put the cards back into the circle. Next persons turn.



Version 2

Learners make a circle. Lay picture cards down and word cards up.

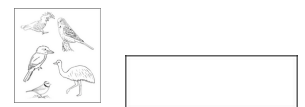
A learner turns over a picture card and says it aloud. Then they have to match it to the right word card. Learner says the word aloud again. If they match, they hold onto the card. If not, they put the cards back into the circle. Next persons turn.



Version 3

Learners make a circle. Lay picture cards up and word cards down.

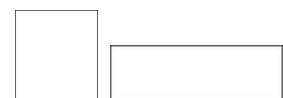
learner turns over a word card and says it aloud. Then they have to match it to the right picture card. Learner says the word aloud again. If they match, they hold onto the cards. If not, they put the cards back into the circle. Next persons turn.



Version 4

Learners make a circle. Lay picture and word cards face down.

learner turns over a word card and a picture card, saying the word aloud each time. If they match, learner keeps the cards. If they don't, they go back into the circle. Next persons turn.



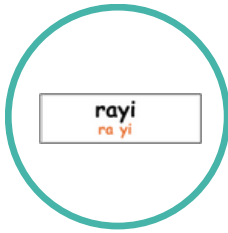
Fly Squat Game



What you need

Instructional language

'Let's make a circle (you all).'

'You (one person) put **word/picture** paper **down/up**'

'Hit/Touch it' (you, one person).

'You (one person) say it.'

'Yes/No' 'Gently.' 'Slowly.'

How to play

Version 1



Learners make a circle. Lay picture cards face up.

Teacher gives two learners a fly squat each. Teacher says a word in language and learners have to race to find the right picture card. First one to squat the picture and say the word aloud wins!

Version 2



Learners make a circle. Lay word cards face up.

Teacher gives two learners a fly squat each. Teacher says a word in English and learners have to race to find the word card in language. First one to squat the picture and say the word aloud in language wins!
